Spelling: We are looking at Unit 26.

Hymnology: We will be learning Palm Sunday hymn "Hosanna, Ride on" for this Wednesday. For next Wednesday, we will recite our hymn 152:1-2, 5.

Novel: We are reading Julie of the Wolves and are learning more of Julie's past and why she found herself in the tundra lost to begin with.

Language arts: 6th will be learning about Pronouns. 5th grade will be taking a test this week.
