100th Days and Valentine's Day –On Friday, Feb. 14th the students will celebrate Valentine's Day. They are welcome to bring valentines and/or treats to share with their friends. Our 100th Day of School will be <u>THURSDAY</u>, Feb. 20th. We will have many 100th day activities. One activity is our 100 "chex" mix snack activity. Each child is asked to bring in 100 small food items that can be mixed together to make a classroom snack. An example of items brought in the past: mini marshmallows, gummy bears, yogurt or chocolate covered raisins, pretzels, m and m's, Cheerios, Bugles, etc. Each student's items can be placed in a plastic ziplock bag.
