Book Project and Presentation – The students have chosen a book in which they will learn about an animal. In school, they will be taking notes about details they read in their book and on some educational sites online. Next week the students will work at home compiling the information into a book report that will be presented to the class. They will also



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work at home on a project depicting the animal and some of the details they have learned about the animal. Some project suggestions: mobile with detailed facts, diorama, shoebox setting designed with the animal and its setting, Flip book on the life cycle of the animal, poster board with animal details, etc. Presentation and book project are due on Friday, May 19.
