100<sup>th</sup> Days and Valentine’s Day –On Friday, Feb. 14<sup>th</sup> the students will celebrate Valentine’s Day. They are welcome to bring valentines and/or treats to share with their friends. Our 100<sup>th</sup> Day of School will be THURSDAY, Feb. 20<sup>th</sup>. We will have many 100<sup>th</sup> day activities. One activity is our 100 “chex” mix snack activity. Each child is asked to bring in 100 small food items that can be mixed together to make a classroom snack. An example of items brought in the past: mini marshmallows, gummy bears, yogurt or chocolate covered raisins, pretzels, m and m’s, Cheerios, Bugles, etc. Each student’s items can be placed in a plastic ziplock bag.
