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## 1st and 2nd Grade

100<sup>th</sup> Day and Valentine's Day – The last few years, when I add our 100<sup>th</sup> day party to the weekly preview, we end up with a snow day before our party day. So, baring having any days off, we will have our 100<sup>th</sup> day celebration on Monday, February 17, and our Valentines party on Friday, Feb. 14<sup>th</sup>. The students are welcome to bring valentines to share with their friends on Friday, Feb. 14<sup>th</sup>. For our 100<sup>th</sup> Day of School, will have many 100<sup>th</sup> day activities. One activity is our 100 “chex” mix snack activity. Each child is asked to bring in 100 small food items that can be mixed together to make a classroom snack.
