Simple Yet Profound-

(A devotion based on this week's hymn: "God Loved the World So That He Gave" CW 570)

This week's hymn is based on one of the simplest summaries of the gospel there is: "God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16). It is a passage we know well. It is one of the first passages we learned as children. Perhaps the temptation is to think we can move beyond such simple things.

And yet the thought of this verse and this hymn is profound. God, who is far above and beyond the world he made, does not stay far away. He does not just know from a distance that we exist and that we do not deserve his attention. In fact, he gives us more than his attention. He gives us his love. That's amazingly profound. He loves the world and those who live in it so much that he gave his dearest treasure. He gave his one and only Son who came into the world to live and die to save the world from sin.

That is the simple truth that is the foundation of our faith, life, and teaching. God deals with us in love. The greatest display of that love is Jesus, who gave himself up to save us. Those who believe in him and his work will join him forever in heaven. Knowing this truth changes how we live each day of our lives. Treasure this simple yet profound truth. Ponder its depths. You will never exhaust its meaning.

Prayer: Dear Jesus, as we struggle through life and still falter in our weakness, help us grasp the width, the length, the height, and the depth of your love for us. Renew us each day in your gospel promise that our sins have been washed away and that we are free to live a new life in you. Grant this for your name's sake. Amen.
