One Little Word-

(A devotion based on this week's hymn: "A Mighty Fortress is Our God" CW 863)

So often we only believe what we can see. If we can't see the power of God on display in our lives, sometimes we begin to question whether he's really there. And doesn't that same attitude also apply to our dealings with Satan and his demons?

Hollywood has, we might say, romanticized Satan. We are drawn to this dark world of movies and stories about demon possession. That amazing "other worldly" power is scary, but strangely fascinating. But when Satan doesn't attack that way, do we tend to wonder whether he's really there? I sometimes wonder if we forget or disregard how terrifying the power of Satan really is.

Just think of it: Apathy toward the sacraments, indifference to God's Word, a lack of care for the truth of the gospel—that's how Satan so often attacks you and me. Not as a fire breathing dragon but as a subtle voice of human reason and sinful pleasure.

But now, consider the strength and power that Luther describes in his famous Reformation hymn "A Mighty Fortress Is Our God." With the dangers that we face, we need the strength that only God can provide. We need the defense that can only come from him. And he gives it to us so simply . . . "one little word," if you will.

How insulting to Satan that what it takes to defeat him is not majestic, magical, "other worldly" tools, but he is defeated with a simple word of forgiveness through faith in Jesus Christ proclaimed by mortal flesh and blood. Simple bread and wine and water, connected with God's Word, and Satan stands no chance. This gospel is so simple, but the gospel is all we need. Satan can "scowl fierce as he will, he can harm us none. He's judged; the deed is done! One little word can fell him" (st. 3).
