# Hymn of the Week

Our hymn this week is "O Come, O Come Emmanuel" (CW 327 - this is the new hymnal number). In very Biblical, picturesque language, the hymn writer of this ancient Latin text gives names to Jesus that are more than just titles but attributes of our Savior. The term "Emmanuel" (sometimes spelled "Immanuel") itself means "God with us" - and that is truly what we have in Jesus!
