"The Word"-

(A devotion based on this week's hymn: "God's Word is Our Great Heritage" - CW 640)

"The grass withers and the flowers fall, but the word of the Lord endures forever."

(1 Peter 1:24b,25a)

The expression "Word of God," or "Word of the Lord," or just "the Word" occurs dozens of times in Scripture. In some instances, as in John chapter 1, "the Word" refers to Jesus. But in most cases, God's Word tells us what he has revealed about himself. It is through the Word of the gospel that we become children of God, and it is that same Word that keeps us in the faith.

The writer of this hymn text, Nikolai F. S. Grundtvig, intended for this stanza to be a fifth stanza to "A Mighty Fortress Is Our God," Martin Luther's great Reformation hymn. Stanza 4 of Luther's hymn begins with "The Word they still shall let remain." Grundtvig follows up that thought with the reminder that Christians have inherited this wonderful gift and that it is our task, our great endeavor, to share the message of that Word. This Word guides us in our life and sustains us as we face the ravages of death. The final lines of the hymn are a prayer that we keep the teachings of Scripture pure and that we continue to pass the wonderful news of the gospel to future generations.

Prayer: Lord, keep us steadfast in your Word. Fill us with the zeal to daily study that precious Word and to proclaim it to the next generation. We ask this in the name of Jesus who is the Word made flesh. Amen.
