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## Notes from the Teachers

**Preschool** This week the students will be having fun with the letter *B*. Parents were asked to send something that starts with *B* for show and tell as well as a snack such as *Bananas*, *Blueberries* etc. Anything added or taken away from these plans will be noted on Fridays Weekly Review email. It's great to hear from so many parents that the students are enjoying school!

- Our bible lessons will include "The Wise Men" and "God Keeps Jesus Safe from Herod".
- Science- *B* for *Body*. Tracing each student's entire body outline on large paper and labeling all of the parts. One of our crafts will be "cooking" which I like to consider science. We will be making *Blue* playdough from scratch (to keep here at school).
- Math- Graphing the number of students with different *B* word features such as *Blue/Brown* eyes, and *Blonde/ Brunette/ Black* hair using colored snap cubes. Measuring the lengths of arms and legs etc. from our science body outlines using snap cubes. Our playdough craft also includes math and measuring. If time allows we will play *Number Bingo*.
- Literacy- Forming letter *B* on playdough mats (eventually using our homemade *Blue* playdough), dry erase handwriting letter practice, letter *B* hunt, letter *B* tongue twisters, *Alphabet Bingo*. Our read aloud books are "*Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What Do You See?*" by Eric Carle and "*We're Going On A Bear Hunt*" by Michael Rosen.
- Crafts- *B* for *Bumblebee* craft, *Blue* playdough from scratch recipe, and painting with *Bubbles*.
- Music and Movement- Songs include "Going on a *Bear Hunt*" with our read aloud book. "*B-I-N-G-O*" with our math bingo. "*The B-i-b-l-e That's the Book for Me*" with bible time. "*Apples and Bananas*" from last week's *Apple A* theme. "*Head Shoulders Knees and Toes*", "*Hokey Pokey*" and "*Simon Says*" with our *Body* science project. "*Betsy the Banana*" yoga.
- Other fun if time allows- *Bean Bag* toss and *Balloon* catch.
