#### COUNCIL ACTIVITY

The Worship Committee via the Board of Elders recommended that we purchase the new Christian Worship hymnal and begin using them next year. The church council is considering that recommendation and hopes to bring a recommendation to the Annual Meeting in January.

In the October meeting, the insurance committee met with the church council. The council recommended changing the WELS VEBA insurance coverage from Plan 2 to Plan 4. The council then promised to pick up any charges that would be beyond the current coverage of Plan 2. Jamie Siferd would serve as the administrator of the health insurance plans at Trinity.

The Projects Committee is looking at replacing the playground at the corner of Allen and High St with a playground that is more appropriate for preschool and kindergartners. They also continue work on the parsonage renovation.
