Call meeting summary: On September 19, the Voter's decided to pause the calling process for a co-pastor, principal and teachers to discuss other options for calls. At the council meeting, the Council is recommending to call a Principal to lead the school and assist pastor with ministry responsibilities at church, like leading Sunday School and teaching a Bible Class. Church council also recommended calling a 1st and 2nd grade teacher to fill the vacancy left, when Ms. Jensen leaves at the end school year to live with her future husband in Wisconsin. At this time, the council also recommended that we hold off on calling a 2nd pastor or an additional 7th & 8th grade teacher.

Insurance Committee: Presented their report to church council. They recommended to have our called workers sign up for insurance through the Affordable Care Act. The driving principle for this decision was to keep similar insurance coverage to the current coverage, while trying to ease the financial burden on the congregation. The proposal was discussed, as well as option of staying with WELS VEBA, but going with a more affordable plan that would reimburse the called workers of any extra costs incurred. After some discussion, the council wanted more information on the WELS VEBA plan before making a recommendation.
