**“The Baptismal River”**

(A devotion based on the hymn “Go, My Children, With My Blessing” CW 930 - This is the final hymn for many of our students this year and also a wonderful hymn for the end of the school year - and really anytime!)

“In my love’s baptismal river I have made you mine forever.” (st. 1)

Rivers can be dangerous places. Most people don’t want their children playing along riverbanks unsupervised. Every year we hear about both drownings and brave rescues. Some unbaptized students and some of their unbaptized parents look at Baptism as dangerous. They connect it with having to give up vices that they like, and they don’t really like us talking about Baptism. It’s threatening.

Baptism really is threatening to our sinful natures. Luther said, “Baptism means that the old Adam in us should be drowned by daily contrition and repentance, and that all of its evil deeds and desires be put to death.” Put to death.

By contrast, many people have learned the joy of river activities. Fishing, boating, and skiing can take place very safely on rivers. Rivers are vital for commerce and are valuable natural resources.

God’s baptismal river is also valuable. In fact, it’s vital. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved. Baptism works forgiveness of all of the sins of the sinful nature and delivers us from death and the devil.

This hymn is a musical setting of God speaking his blessing to us. A big part of that blessing is God’s baptizing us and making us his own—forever. His love to us in Christ rolls on like a river, and lends joy to all of our daily activities. Whether on a riverbank, at school, or at home, we are never alone. God is with us, blessing us.

**We are beginning to receive confirmation of application submissions and initial awards of scholarships for Trinity. We can not stress enough how beneficial it is to work through the steps of this process to determine eligibility. Any eligible student receives an award of at least \$3800 which will be used to support the school and help us provide the best resources possible.**

### **Call News -**

This past Sunday, the voters of Trinity were led to Call Mr. Samuel Evans as our 7th & 8th grade teacher. This is a very unique Call for a few reasons: 1) Mr. Evan's school will be closing at the end of this school year leaving him without a Call. 2) He was in the Principal Training Program and was in his second year. The program is three years and he would be in his third year of this program if he were to accept our Call. 3) He may be eligible for Calls in the coming year, but would not be required to accept them. 4) He may have received other Calls from schools in a similar situation as ours.

We pray God grants him wisdom and peace as he considers where he might use his gifts best in the years ahead!

The voters also approved requesting an emergency teacher IF our 7th & 8th grade Call is returned. This is not a guarantee either. There are 7 individuals who have offered to serve as an emergency teacher in the upcoming school year. Emergency teachers have finished at least 3 full years of schooling at Martin Luther College AND have most likely completed at least one session of student teaching. We will keep you all updated as well as we can as we continue in this process.
