God's Hug for You

(This week's devotion is based on the hymn our students will be studying: "Go, My Children, with My Blessing" CW 930)

It is amazing what a hug can do. It releases tension, builds trust, heals loneliness, elevates our mood, and can even create happiness.

Have you gotten a hug today from someone in your life?

Now get ready for a hug from God. Long ago he told the first high priest to express his love for the people with a blessing on their heads: "The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make his face shine on you and be gracious to you; the LORD turn his face toward you and give you peace" (Numbers 6:23-27).

God's hug continued when the Great High Priest, Jesus Christ, came in person, embraced our humanity, and graciously demonstrated God's love that brings us peace: "While we were still sinners, Christ died for us" (Romans 5:8). After his resurrection, when Jesus visibly left this world in the presence of his disciples, "he lifted up his hands and blessed them" (Luke 24:50). This blessing still remains for us as he sends us out into all the world.

These words of blessing still come from the mouth of God, no matter who speaks them or where they are read. They work like a hug at the end of a worship service or after our first devotional time of the day. Think of it: In love's baptismal river, you are God's own child forever; through the story of his Son, he has touched you with peace and purity; through the holy meal, you are fed and nourished for a life of increased love and improved service.

Enjoy God's hug. Then hug someone who needs his love.
