“Every Single One”

A Devotion based on this week's hymn "It Is Well With My Soul" (CW 850).

In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

You've packed the bags. You've loaded the car. You've made sure the kids have all their snacks and toys. You've completed all the items on your checklist and finally begin your long road trip. Several hours into your trip, however, a thought pops up in the back of your mind. Did I forget to unplug the iron? Or maybe it was I think I may have left the oven on. You now wrack your brain trying to remember definitively whether or not you had taken care of such items, all the while envisioning a smoldering fire or a burnt down house. What do you do? Perhaps you risk it, figuring it's only a small chance that you left those things on, and an even smaller chance that it's going to result in a horrible fire. Still . . . that thought continues to tug at you. You cannot get rid of it until you know for sure one way or another that your house is not in danger. It would be hard to enjoy a vacation while worrying about what you will find when you return home. That thought would continue to weigh on your mind. What about other areas in your life? What about those moments in your life when your sins stir up feelings of guilt and shame and you are just glad that no one else knows about them? Things you may have done and thoughts you may have had that by all rights condemn you in the presence of your holy Father? Rest assured, these are sins—along with the sins of the entire world—that Jesus took upon himself. There was no partial payment for them, but rather a complete, perfect payment once and for all and for all time. That one payment makes us God's children again. What a beautiful message, what great comfort this is for us. Just as the hymn writer says, "My sin—oh, the bliss of this glorious thought— My sin, not in part, but the whole, Is nailed to the cross, and I bear it no more: Praise the Lord, praise the Lord, O my soul!
