"The Perfect Church"

*A Devotion based on this week's hymn "The Church's One Foundation" (CW 855).
In the name of the Father and of the Son ☐ and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.*

The third stanza of this hymn references "those that hate" the church. Do you know someone who hates the church? What does this person understand the church to be? Many who hate the church are thinking of a local congregation or perhaps a church denomination. We must confess that local congregations and denominations are not perfect, and this may at times turn people off and cause them to "hate" the church. What most people fail to understand is that there is a church that is perfect, a church completely pure and holy, a church built on the one foundation that is Christ. This is the holy Christian church, the communion of saints.

Sometimes we may find ourselves being quite critical of our own congregation and the people who are its members. When we start thinking that way and perhaps become upset, it's good for us to think about what this hymn says about the church. This hymn glorifies the church. That church is one; it has one Lord, one faith, partakes of one holy food, and possesses one hope.

In contrast to earthly congregations and church denominations, the holy Christian church "ever shall prevail." That's because its one foundation is Jesus Christ. This church is his new creation, his holy bride. He bought this church with the price of his own blood. To belong to this church is not something we deserve. Rather, it is a great honor and privilege granted to us by grace. May we daily give thanks for the blessings we enjoy because we are members of this holy Christian church.

Prayer: Lord, you are the foundation of the one church to which I belong. Help me to cherish this truth and share this truth with others. Amen.
