#### “Many Feasts!”

(A devotion based on the well-known hymn “At the Lamb’s High Feast We Sing” CW 675 - a hymn the students are studying now.)

What a privilege it is to unpack the powerful images in this hymn. It focuses our attention on Jesus the Lamb of God, who suffered for our sins and then rose victorious to give us the feast of all feasts.

Isaiah the prophet predicted the coming of this great feast with these words: “On this mountain the Lord Almighty will prepare a feast of rich food for all peoples. . . . On this mountain he will destroy the shroud that enfolds all peoples. . . . He will swallow up death forever. . . . The Sovereign LORD will wipe away the tears from all faces” (Isaiah 25:6-8).

So in this hymn we feast on the victorious and risen Christ “who has washed us in the tide, flowing from his pierced side” (st. 1).

We further feast on the victory over Satan with the words “Mighty Victim from the sky, hell’s fierce pow’rs beneath you lie” (st. 5). This high feast celebrates the seed of the woman, the Lamb of God, the victim who was bruised by Satan but is now victorious in the fight. Satan is crushed beneath his feet (Genesis 3:15).

This hymn offers more feasting as we celebrate the victory that is ours over death. “Now no more can death appall, now no more the grave enthrall. You have opened paradise, and your saints in you shall rise” (st. 6).

With this feast of all feasts, the feast of Jesus’ resurrection, comes the daily joy of being free from sin. So we sing, “From sin’s pow’r, Lord, set us free, newborn souls in you to be” (st. 7). Someday soon we will gather together around the throne of the Lamb. We will join our brothers and sisters who have been washed in the blood of Lamb singing, “Salvation belongs to our God, who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb” (Revelation 7:10).

This festival hymn ends with a glorious doxology praising Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, who so carefully prepared for us a feast of all feasts.

#### Closing Prayer:

*“Father, who the crown shall give, Savior, by whose death we live, Spirit guide through all our days. Three in One, your name we praise. Alleluia.” Amen*
