I Am Baptized Into Christ -
(A devotion based on this week's assigned hymn: "God's Own Child, I Gladly Say It" CW 679 - not due until next week after break)

Do you sometimes wish you had been born into a different family—a family with money, status, celebrity, or power? Just think of the benefits you would enjoy if your parents were royalty, billionaires, movie stars, or part of the political elite! You might think you would have it all—everything you ever dreamed of.

This hymn poses an important question: "Do I need earth's treasures many?" (st. 1). We know the answer, but we still benefit from the reminder. Earth's treasures may satisfy for a time, but eventually they will prove worthless. What I really need is someone who can pay the debt I owe for all the times I valued earth's treasures above God and his will. That someone is Jesus. "He, because I could not pay [my sin debt], gave my full redemption price" (st. 1). Jesus paid with his life the debt I owe. And it is in the waters of Baptism that Jesus came to me and united me to himself. He freely brought me all the blessings of salvation, blessings that will never fade or go away, but will last "to eternity."

So, what a joy to say and sing, "I am baptized into Christ!":

- When my sinful failures to keep God's law disturb my soul, I find comfort in the good news that "I am baptized into Christ." (I am forgiven!)
- When Satan accuses me with my guilt, when he tries to get me to doubt God's love, I can say to him, "I am baptized into Christ." (Satan, you cannot separate me from God's love!)
- When the thought of death steals away my joy, I can recall my baptism and declare to myself, "I am baptized into Christ." (I will leave the sadness of this life and inherit the joys of paradise!)

Remember your baptism, because in those waters your gracious God connected you to your Savior, Jesus. He made you his redeemed and forgiven child, an heir of eternal life! With this assurance, you can look sin, Satan, and death in the face and gladly declare that you are “baptized into Christ.” You are “a child of paradise.”

Prayer: Heavenly Father, what a gift of love my baptism is! May your Word of promise, given with water, always fill my soul with joy. When conscience accuses, Satan attacks, and death draws near, remind me of the absolute certainty that I am your child, and fill my heart with peace. Grant this for Jesus’ sake. Amen.
